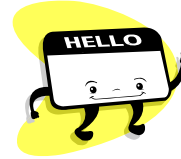

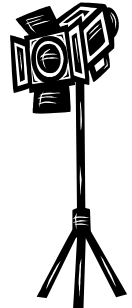

therapists on the sidelines. He's been described as a layman healer. After witnessing a co-worker fall from a scaffold, he went to assist and intuitively knew what to do. He described his talent as a gift and spent a lot of time perfecting his technique. In his last years in practice, Bowen was treating 13,000 people a year. He taught 6 people how to perform treatments with the understanding that it would only be taught after his death. There are now several thousand Bowen practitioners in the world and the numbers are growing. Bowen Therapy has been one of the best kept secrets. In the couple's practice, they have successfully treated many people who have experienced server back pain and trauma. Examples include sciatica and relief from bulging or herniated disks. They also have had great success helping with shoulder and neck issues, TMJ, carpal tunnel, tennis elbow and knee pain.
