PARADE INSTRUCTIONS

1. The parade order of entries in the same category will be determined by date of registration.
2. Assembly for the parade is in the playground of the Fair Oaks School. 10700 Fair Oaks Blvd.
3. Pre-registered paraders, please arrive between 9:00 and 9:30 a.m.
4. Non-registered paraders, please arrive between 8:30 and 9:00 a.m.
5. Please drop off participants in the school's circular drive. There is no parking available, so please bring someone to escort your children to their parade unit if they cannot be on their own.
6. There will be a shuttle service to the parade route available at the Scandinavian Design parking lot next to Taco Bell at Winding Way and Sunrise Blvd., to the parade route.
7. Paraders, please go to your assigned areas determined by your parade order number. .
8. Leaders, please check in with registration.
9. If you have any questions, please check with any organizer. They will be identified with "FOCC Volunteer" vests, and they have a copy of the parade order.
10. The parade will begin at 10:00 am sharp.
11. All parade units must be accompanied by adult.
12. There will be two performance sites on the parade route marked by balloons and an MC. See "X's" on parade route map. Please keep performances to under **2 minutes**.
13. The Group Leader must show the parade unit number so that emcees and judges can see it. You'll get your number with check-in. Performance sites are located:
 - A. By the dental building located at 10425 Fair Oaks Blvd.
 - B. In front of the Fair Oaks Chamber of Commerce, 10244 Fair Oaks Blvd, where judging will take place.
14. At the end of the parade you can pick up paraders in the Fair Oaks Community Clubhouse parking lot, 7997 California Avenue.
15. The awards ceremony, will be at the conclusion of the parade in front of the judging stand. Awards are based upon best representation of theme—"Go Green This Spring."
